The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act was signed into law in March 2009, presenting \$787 billion in funding to help stimulate economic recovery. This Act, known commonly as the Stimulus Bill, includes billions of dollars for the work nonprofits care about: social welfare, education, community development, etc.
